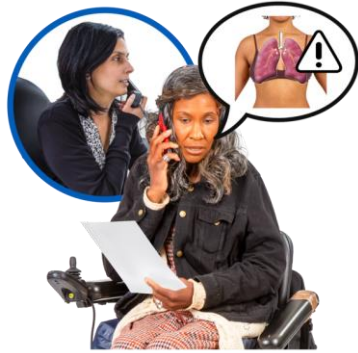
Supported more people to get Annual Health Checks

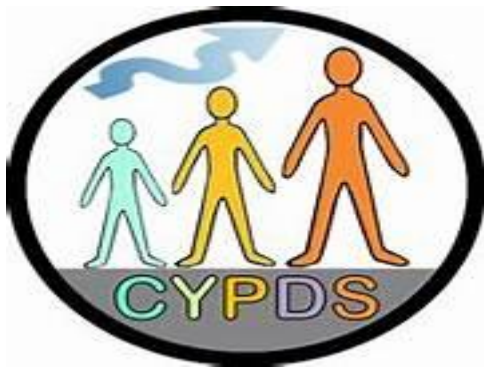
