Technical notes

Statistical significance and confidence intervals

The methodology for determining statistical significance is as follows:

- **Higher:** Camden's lower 95% confidence interval (CI) is above the comparator area's (London or England) upper CI
- **Similar:** Camden's CI overlaps with comparator area's CI
- **Lower:** Camden's upper 95% CI is below the comparator area's lower CI

RAG rating

For some indicators, high figures are good (e.g., vaccine coverage), and for others (e.g., hospital admissions) a low figure is good. In the tartan rug summary for each section, indicator values have been colour-coded using a RAG rating to enable a quick visual interpretation compared to the London benchmark.


- **Red:** statistically worse than the London benchmark

- **Green:** statistically better than the London benchmark

Children in absolute low income families (under 16s)







Percentage of deliveries to women from ethnic minority groups (Female)









Healthy life expectancy at birth (Female)





Inequality in life expectancy at birth (Female)



Inequality in life expectancy at birth (Male)



General fertility rate (Female)























Breastfeeding prevalence at 6 to 8 weeks











Under 16s conception rate / 1,000 (Female)













Hospital admissions for diabetes (under 19 years)









Percentage of looked after children whose emotional wellbeing is a cause for concern





Pupils with special educational needs (SEN): % of school pupils with special educational needs







Hospital admissions as a result of self-harm (10 to 24 years)













Hospital admissions for dental caries (0 to 5 years)





Year 6 prevalence of overweight (including obesity)




















































































































