- What we help people with depends on what support they need and what their goals are



- We started supporting people in 2023 and we want to tell you about what we have been doing



Here are some of the things we can help with

- Writing a good CV
- Applying for jobs
- Practicing for interviews
- Asking for **reasonable adjustments** from an employer
- Finding job opportunities or work experience
- Finding training courses
- Helping people to learn the skills they need for work





- This is the Disability Job Hub Team



- Ellie is the **Disability Job Hub Manager**



- Sarah is the **Learning Disability Job Hub Advisor** and she helps people to get into work



- She can help with things like making a CV and applying for jobs



- Nor is also a Learning Disability Job Hub Advisor and has been covering Sarah while she was on maternity leave



- Leigh is the **Learning Disability Work Ready Coach** and she helps people to get ready to start work



- She can help with things like learning the skills that you need for work, building your confidence and managing your money



- She runs two group training programmes called **Skills for Work** and **Travel Training**



- We showed our ideas for the group sessions to Synergy and they told us if we needed to change anything



- We have run the **Skills for Work Training** 3 times and the **Travel Training** we have run once

- Overall, 28 people with a learning disability have attended some of the training



- This has also helped people to make friends and some people have carried on meeting up at the Social Hub every week after the training finished



- So far we have supported 38 people who have a learning disability



- We have helped 7 of them into a paid job



- We have helped 20 people into training or education



- We have helped 6 people to start volunteering



- We also organised training for employers in how to support a disabled person that works for them
