STEAM Work Experience Programme

Welcome young people on work experience, enabling every 16–18-year-old in Camden to access a placement.

Host a group of young people during Camden's STEAM Work Experience week each July, or commit places on your existing programme to Camden state school students.

Camden STEAM will guide you through the process of planning a high-quality placement and support you in recruiting students from local schools.

T Levels and Apprenticeships

Recruit and welcome young people through STEAM T Level industry placements and apprenticeships.

Work with us to create a Camden STEAM T Level placement or apprenticeship in your organisation.

Camden STEAM can support you in connecting with local schools and promoting your STEAM apprenticeship opportunities.

STEAM Ambassadors

Deliver career activities in schools to help us reach every young person, every year.

STEAM Ambassadors are at the heart of the STEAM Pledge – a network of employee volunteers supporting primary and secondary schools across Camden.

They engage with students in a range of ways: from giving assembly talks and leading workshops to hosting students in the workplace.

Camden STEAM supports Ambassadors and helps coordinate activities that make a real impact on young people.

STEAM Hub

Work with Camden teachers, sharing industry expertise to bring the curriculum to life through projects and visits.

Camden's broad network of teachers welcome opportunities to visit STEAM workplaces and see technology, creative industries, engineering, science and maths in action.

Visits allow teachers to learn about the industries relevant to their teaching, bring practical insights back to their classrooms enhancing students' learning and can also spark longer-term partnerships and projects with local schools.

London AI Campus

Google in collaboration with Camden Learning and Camden Council's STEAM programme has launched the London AI Campus, to create opportunities and reduce barriers to accessing into and with the AI industry for students.

To enrich Camden's students' learning, the Campus welcomes employer expertise to inspire and educate students through an innovative programme of masterclasses, workshops, mentoring and learning programmes.
